Month 1 would include the time of reflection, the presentation of the theme by a member of the formation team (or the one so designated), and the sharing of other insights on that theme by the candidates from the other resources read. Month 2 would include the reflection again, plus the group sharing of answers to the questions, plus any insights or observations from the personal study and the activities. Before the beginning of the next session would be celebrated the liturgical service from the previous lesson.</p>
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
